MINUTES:

BoS Meeting of the Department of English was held on 09.12.2020 at 11.00 am on Zoom. The Meeting started with HoD of English Dr. S.J. Earnest introducing the Members of the Board and initiating the discussion on the new syllabus for I Degree General English introduced by APSCHE wef 2020-2021, the copies of which had been forwarded to the Members.

Dr. S.J. Earnest expressed his opinion that there could be no change in the Syllabus of Semester I, because it is exclusively a Course in **Communication and Soft Skills**. Members accepted this suggestion.

Prof. E. Dileep, University Representative of the Affiliating University, Krishna University suggested that a speech by Nethaji Subhash Chandra Bose at the Hooghly District Students' Conference in Chinsurah on 22 July 1929 may be selected as one of the Prose Selections in Unit I of Semester II.

All the Members participated in the discussion thoroughly and made some suggestions for modifications in the Syllabus of Semester II, including that of the suggestion of Prof. Dileep.

Basing on the deliberations, the following changes have been made in Semester II:

1. In Unit I, "How to Avoid Foolish Opinions" by Bertrand Russell is replaced with Nethaji Subhash Chandra Boses's "The Individual, the Nation, and the Ideal".
2. Booker T. Washinton's "My Struggle for an Education" is included as additional reading in Unit I.
3. "Collocations" is removed in Unit I, as a new Prose Lesson is included in it.
4. In Unit II, P.B. Shelley's "Ode to the West Wind" is replaced with John Keats' ballad "La Belle Dame Sans Merci".
5. In Unit III, Rabindranath Tagore's poem "Upagupta" is replaced with "Where the Mind is without Fear" of the same poet.
6. In Unit III, the Prose Selection "The Night Train at Deoli" written by Ruskin Bond is replaced with Kushwant Singh's essay "English Zindabad Vs. Angrezi Hatao".
7. In Unit IV, the Poem "Coromandel Fishers" by Sarojini Naidu is replace with Adelaide Procter's Lyrical Poem "These Little Acts of Kindness".
8. In Unit IV, Serial No. 3, "Notices, Agendas and Minutes" is removed.
9. The Detailed Prose Lesson in Unit II "The Doll's House" written by Katherine Mansfield is made into Non-Detailed Lesson in Unit V and the Non-Detailed Lesson in Unit V "An Astrologer's Day" written by R.K. Narayan is made into a Detailed Lesson in Unit II.
10. Existing Syllabus of I B.A. Special English (Adv. English) will be retained for the next cycle as it is, because APSCHE has not given any new one.



RESOLUTIONS:

The following Resolutions have been made with the consent of the Members:

1. It is resolved to follow the Syllabus of **Semester I** given by APSCHE in toto without any changes.
2. It is also resolved to approve the above-mentioned changes suggested by majority of the Members of the BOS in **Semester II**.

4. Resolved also to wait for Krishna University to issue Model Question Papers of Semester I & II for General English and to chalk out the same as and when it is released.
